

Thanksgiving dishes out a platter of variety on television as well as on tables

Thanksgiving, so is the television programming that also marks the official start of the holiday season.

Many networks won't disappoint this year on Thursday, Nov. 24, with certain main courses of that day as well as other dishes. Here's some you'll want to add to your viewing plate.

"Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade" (NBC): The 90th procession -- again overseen by "Today" personalities -- winds its way through Manhattan from Central Park West to Herald Square, with the usual array of floats, character balloons, guest performers and numbers from current Broadway musicals. And, of course, a jolly fellow with the last name Claus puts the capper on the festivities.

"Anne of Green Gables" (PBS. check local listings): The beloved Lucv Maud Montgomery story gets a new, filmed-in-Canada retelling, with Ella Ballentine in the title role of the spirited orphan who has a deep impact on the brother and sister (Martin Sheen, Sara Botsford) who take her in.

"The Wonderful World of Disney: Magical

Holiday Celebration" (ABC): Siblings, and "Dancing With the Stars" staples, Julianne and Derek Hough keep the family feel of the holiday by hosting this special originating mainly from Florida's Walt Disney World. Kelly Clarkson and spouses Garth Brooks and Trisha Yearwood are slated to perform.

"The Thanksgiving Dav Parade on CBS": The network again observes its holiday-morning ritual, spotlighting festivities in various cities ... including New York's Macv's Thanksgiving Day Parade. Kevin Frazier ("Entertainment Tonight") and Keltie Knight ("The Insider") anchor, and musical quests include Sting and Miranda Lambert.

NFL Football (CBS, NBC, Fox): For those who can't get through the holiday without watching big games, several match-ups are on tap: the Minnesota Vikings at the Detroit Lions (CBS) and the Washington Redskins at the Dallas Cowboys (Fox) in the daytime, and the Pittsburgh Steelers at the Indianapolis Colts (NBC) at night.

"The National Dog Show" (NBC): The Kennel Club of Thanksgiving? This one might make you feel better.

Philadelphia's event - in which 2.000 canines vie for the As much as turkey and the trimmings are traditions of coveted title Best in Show -- returns to the airwaves for the 15th consecutive year with John O'Hurley ("Seinfeld") as host, David Frei as analyst and Mary Carillo, Tara Lipinski and Johnny Weir as reporters.

"Father of the Bride" (Turner Classic Movies): Comfortable, family-themed fare will be the order of the holiday on the channel, including the original 1950 version of

the comedy with Spencer Tracy as the father and Elizabeth Taylor as the bride.

Thanksgiving **Episode** Marathon (Food Network):

You'll likely have the day's meal planned out by the time this begins, but if you need any last-minute tips, "Pioneer Woman," 'Valerie's Home "Beat Cooking," Bobby Flay" and other shows will offer them.

> Bond James Marathon (Epix):

Someone simply has to showcase the world's most famous secret agent every Thanksgiving, and this time, the titles range from some of the earliest (Sean Connery's "From Russia With Love" and "Goldfinger") to the latest (Daniel Craig's "Spectre") - and the festival c007ntinues the next day.

(Sorry. We had to.) "Flip or Flop" Marathon (HGTV): There's actually one of these every Thursday, but since home is especially where the heart is on Thanksgiving, it might be even more appropriate to watch Tarek and Christina El Moussa perform their house-renovating magic.

John Wayne Festival (AMC): The holidays also mean a day with "The Duke" at some point, and such classics as "The Man Who Shot Liberty Valance." "The Sons of Katie Elder" and "The Shootist" - Wayne's last film - are on tap this time.

Comedy-Block Marathon (TBS): Since Thanksgiving is known for big helpings, extended doses of such sitcoms as "Friends," "The Big Bang Theory" and "The King of Queens" will maintain that spirit.

"Back to the Future" Marathon (TNT): Marty McFly (Michael J. Fox) will be doing a lot of holiday time-tripping, with the complete comedy-fantasy trilogy being shown. "Chrisley Knows Best" Marathon (USA Network):



If you're a music lover and at all interested in how it gets made, then "Soundbreaking" is required viewing.

Premiering Monday, Nov. 14, and airing weeknights through Nov. 23 on PBS (check local listings), the eight-part, eight-hour series explores the impact of recorded music on the modern world, combining rare archival footage with interviews with celebrated artists, producers and innovators from across the musical spectrum.

The list of the more than 150 interviewees reads like a who's who of popular music: recording artists Paul McCartney, Elton John, Joni Mitchell, Roger Daltrey, RZA, Tom Petty, B.B. King, Willie Nelson, Bonnie Raitt, Roger Waters and Ringo Starr; and producers Quincy Jones, Rick Rubin, Linda Perry, Don Was, Peter Asher and Hank Shocklee. And the episodes are replete with stories of how careers got made and rescued, how songs were crafted and how personalities meshed - or not.

The series was a passion project for Sir George Martin, the famed Beatles producer who served as executive producer of the project before his death this past March.

Monday's opening episode, "The Recording Artist," focuses on the mysterious role of the record producer, who it seems is equal parts technical whiz, psychologist, protector, mentor and mother,

"In the first hour of the series, George's vision was to really explore how technology has transformed the sound of popular music," series producer/director Jeff Dupre explained to a recent gathering of journalists in Beverly Hills, Calif., "and when we were trying to figure out how to organize the series thematically, we were like, 'Let's start with

the dramatist personae, the people and these human relationships that are at the heart of so many great recordings."

"We felt like, in order to really understand that, we had to have some great contrast between different producers," he continues. So, you know, George Martin's approach to the Beatles was almost Socratic in that he enabled them to, sort of, realize their best selves as artists. And then you contrast that with someone like Phil Spector who, sort of, has this dictatorial vision of what he wants. And, of course, the result is brilliant, but it's a very different relationship with the artist."

And Asher, a record producer and half of the 1960s pop duo Peter and Gordon, can certainly speak to that relationship from both sides.

"Not much is known about what record producers do, including us," he says. "In other words, we don't know because the interesting thing about all of this is we don't know what each other do. We don't get to watch each other in the studio. We are like everyone else. We get to hear the results and kind of go, 'Wow, that sounds cool. How did they do that?' And, eventually, maybe we figure it out."

"And what surprised me, watching (the series), was how much it turns out we do have in common, certain themes that we all talked about: making the artist comfortable in the studio, stopping people from doing a million vocals when they have already done a great one live at the beginning. There's a lot of areas where we find ourselves in agreement without any kind of collaboration because, unlike musicians, producers don't get to work together."

It took a while for Mandy Moore to land a non-animated primetime series, but the wait definitely has proven to be worth it for her.

After several unsold pilots and guest arcs on such shows as "Grey's Anatomy" and "Red Band Society," the singer-actress is delighted with her place on one of this season's top new hits, NBC's Tuesday drama "This Is Us." With a structure that shifts the timeline as she plavs Rebecca – mother to "The Big Three," who include a black youngster adopted after she and then-husband Jack (Milo Ventimiglia) lost one of their own babies in childbirth - the ever-pleasant Moore is enjoying the emotional and sometimes physical challenges built into the role.

"I've never been here before." she admits of the reception to the show by critics and viewers alike, "so I'm just very appreciative. I think we all are. I think we knew that this was a special project, regardless of whether it moved forward or not ... that it was something we'd be proud of at the end of the day. And beyond that, everything was out of our control."

From the start, Moore was "aware-ish" – as she puts it – of what the arc of Rebecca would be, though the "This Is Us" audience has come to anticipate surprises.

"There's a rough outline of what's going to be happening in each episode," Moore explains, "but I think it was more a trajectory for us to know the milestone moments and experiences. They obviously inform our characters, and they affect (fellow 'This Is Us' stars) Justin (Hartley) and Chrissy (Metz) and Sterling (K. Brown) as well. They need to know what happened in their (characters') childhoods, because that's obviously going to carry into their adult lives."

The result has Moore "thrilled." she maintains. "because I feel like I'm an actor in this part. This opportunity has allowed me so many places to go and to be able to dig in ... as a woman, as a wife, as a mother. It feels pretty limitless."

HBO's 'Marathon: The Patriots Day Bombing' chronicles healing in the wake of tragedy

Patriots Day is historically a day of celebration in Boston.

Observed each year on the third Monday in April, it commemorates the Battles of Lexington and Concord, the first military engagements of the American Revolution, on April 19, 1775. In Massachusetts, it's a holiday that closes businesses and schools, sees the Boston Red Sox play an 11 a.m. home game and brings out thousands for the Boston Marathon. Along its 26.2-mile route, it's one big party.

But on April 15, 2013, two pressure-cooker bombs detonated 12 seconds apart turned a joyous occasion into a scene of horror on Boyleston St., as three people lav dead and more than 260 were injured. The explosions were linked to two brothers from Eastern Europe, one of whom was killed during police pursuit.

The stories of some survivors are told in the HBO documentary "Marathon: The Patriots Day Bombing," premiering Monday, Nov. 21. The two-hour film uses surveillance footage, news clips, home movies and exclusive interviews with survivors and their families, along with police, first responders and reporters, to paint a picture of people facing the enormous challenges of physical and emotional recovery with courage and, in some cases, humor as they try to reclaim their lives.

"The stories were so compelling and they hadn't been told," explains Ricki Stern, who directed the documentary with filmmaking partner Annie Sundberg, "and we felt ultimately ... that in telling these survivors' stories, that it reflects a much bigger story of the im-

pact, the concentric circles of impact that one incident has on not just the immediate people who are impacted and affected or injured but the whole community and ultimately we as a nation."

The film begins by recounting the events of that sunny spring day, from the moments before the attacks to the aftermath, including the blood-soaked sidewalks, the investigation and the apprehension of the two suspects.

The film then delves into the stories of the injured, three families with members who lost limbs, were critically hurt or suffered from PTSD. As the documentary progresses, we learn some have healed faster than others and a few are still struggling with their injuries. One story, that of newlywed Jessica Kensky, is particularly heart-wrenching. At this writing, the double amputee required more surgery.

And they're not the only sufferers, as uninjured family members and friends also struggle to cope with the bombing's impact on their loved ones and lives.

The subject matter is obviously very heavy, but there is an undercurrent of optimism that runs through the film as the victims try to make the best of their situations.

"The film is, as I think you might say, very uplifting, and in some ways experiencing it is very cathartic - if you like a good cry," says Sundberg with a wry chuckle. "But there is some humor and I think it's really about the human spirit."

Anyone looking for some time- and hassle-saving tips for Thanksgiving dinner would do well to check out a new special airing this week on Cooking Channel.

In "Tia Mowry Thanksgiving Special," airing Sunday, Nov. 13, the actress, working mom and home chef invites viewers into her home with family and friends to share favorite holiday recipes, entertaining tips and more.

And for her, it's all about preparation.

"It's all about finding meals that you can prep ahead of time and that's exactly what I did for this special," she says. "One in particular, the turkey. So the turkey, a lot of people are intimidated by the turkey. They're like 'Oh my aosh! I don't think I could do it.' But my goal is - and especially for this special - is to show people that yes, you can tackle the bird."

And for Mowry, the first step is brining – immersing the turkey in a solution of water, salt, sugar and herbs for 24 hours – a process she says produces "a really nice, juicy and flavorful turkey."

After that, she lets the bird sit for another 12 hours. Then it's into the oil-less air fryer it goes, covered in peanut oil and creole seasoning. After it cooks for two to three hours, depending on size, it's done.

"What it is is infrared heat that is used to circulate around the turkey, and so it's cooking evenly," she explains. "It's giving it a nice, crispy skin and it's also keeping it really nice and juicy. And there's no mess. There's no oil. There's no clean-up. It's crazy how easy this is."

To go with the bird, she prepares stuffing in little pumpkins, which can be discarded after the meal. The flower arrangements are premade and then refrigerated. And for dessert, it's pumpkin pecan pies in little jars.

The idea is to cook with as few pots as possible, make clean-up easy and thus free the chef from the kitchen.

"When I first started cooking Thanksgiving (dinner) for my family

... I would cook thinas in different pots and then I was left doing the dishes for three hours." she says with a laugh. "Nobody wants to do that."

What book are you currently reading? "The book that I'm currently reading is the book that I read to my son every single night (laughs). I read to my son every single night and that book is the kids' National Geographic book for sharks. And so I read that to him



every single night and so I'm learning about sharks." What did you have for dinner last night?

"Every single time I come into New York, whether I have someone with me, whether it's my husband or friend or if I'm by myself, I go to this restaurant called lppudo and it's basically a Japanese ramen restaurant. So what I had was I had ramen and then I had these amazing fried chicken glazed sticky buns from Ippudo. It's so incredibly good."

What is your next project?

"I'm going to be working on (her regular Cooking Channel series) 'Tia Mowry at Home,' so I'm going to be going into production for that. I'm going to be going into my third season and I'm really excited."

When was your last vacation, where and why?

"My last vacation was this past summer in June and I went to Anguilla with my family. It's amazing. It's one of my favorite places in the world."
