



Eddie Huang knows the ins and outs of a culture clash. The chef and television food-show personality's Asian-American family lived one in the 1990s, when they relocated from Washington, D.C., to Orlando – each member dealing with the transition differently, as Huang recounted in his 2013 memoir. The book becomes a same-named ABC sitcom when "Fresh Off the Boat" premieres with two episodes Wednesday, Feb. 4, then settles into its regular slot the following Tuesday.

Hudson Yang plays the young Huang, whose brothers are portrayed by Ian Chen and Forrest Wheeler. Their American-dream-pursuing, steakhouse-running father and cook-at-home mother (Randall Park, Constance Wu) have differing views of making the move to a new locale ... but they won't hesitate to put up a united front, threatening to sue the school if one of their sons is expelled after being taunted by a new classmate.

Yang auditioned on tape to play Huang, and the young actor says, "It's been a lot of fun. It's my first big thing, and it's been a great time hanging out with Eddie and everybody who's been in the show." Huang considers his on-screen counterpart "awesome. This was the toughest role to cast. What I liked about Hudson is how real he was. He's very raw, and he hasn't been consumed by this whole process."

Noting "this is not an easy show to make," Huang wrote a recent article in which he deemed the series "pasteurized network television" while allowing that it still reflects that "the feeling of being different is universal." ABC Entertainment president Paul Lee responds, "We love Eddie. He's a firebrand. It's a comedy, and the show is not a documentary of his book."

Huang maintains, "I care the most about the conversation that's going to happen because of this show. It's important for me that the show stays responsible to the book and the Asian community, and to people of color in general. And I believe the show is doing that."

Clearly, Huang's parents are barometers of that, but he says, "My mom never read the book. She could care less. She just wants the checks. My dad was really proud of me. I showed him the pilot, and he understood what the show was doing. And I think the show is strategic and smart in how it's easing the viewer into that."



A family's LOYALTIES are tested in espionage drama ALLEGIANCE

Adapted from a hit Israeli program called "The Gordin Cell," the new series stars Hope Davis ("The Newsroom") and Scott Cohen ("Necessary Roughness") as Katya and Mark O'Connor, who have spent the past 25 years or so living quietly in New York and raising their three children after leaving her native Russia.

Of those children, only the eldest, Natalie (Margarita Levieva, "Revenge"), knows the truth about her parents: Katya, the daughter of a KGB general, and Mark, a businessman, have done covert work for the Russian intelligence agency. Natalie, in fact, has also done her share of spying, much against her parents' wishes.

The other two O'Connor children – including middle child Alex (newcomer Gavin Stenhouse), who is just starting a career as an analyst for the CIA – have no idea about their parents' secret past, however. That changes dramatically in the series premiere, as Mark and Katya's KGB handler, Victor (Morgan Spector), unexpectedly resurfaces with a startling demand: The KGB wants Alex turned to become an asset for them.

"Alex is new to the CIA, a 'baby analyst,' as Katya calls him," Davis explains. "I don't know whether the KGB was tracking him previously, but I think when he is called in for a special assignment, that is what really puts him on the KGB radar."

Alex, we quickly learn, falls somewhere on the spectrum for autism, which makes it challenging for him to perform some mundane tasks yet also enables him to notice patterns "normal" colleagues don't see. He also is blessed with eidetic memory, which plays a key role in the first episode.

"Gavin has done a tremendous amount of research on the subject (of autism) and was very diligent about sending us all sorts of things long



before we started shooting," Davis says. "There is so much written about this in the press now, about children with Asperger's. But in the years when Alex was a child, that was back before the word 'spectrum' (in this context) was even part of our national language. It was a much trickier thing 25 years ago. Now there are so many more resources for parents. I think Katya and Mark were very much in the dark about what was going on with Alex."


As the story unfolds, it becomes apparent that the show's title has multiple levels of meaning.

"For awhile, we had the title 'Coercion,' and we were casting about for a title we felt was more able to convey some of the complexity of the show," says executive producer George Nolfi. "The great thing about 'Allegiance' is that, obviously, it has all of the national connotations, but there's also allegiance to your job and to your family. At its core, this show is about the dilemma among these people in terms of their allegiance to their family versus their country."



Bayonne Bridge Construction Update

Mayor Jimmy Davis announced that the Port Authority of New York and New Jersey has provided new information about the latest developments in the Bayonne Bridge construction project.

The gantry has completed its load and performance testing. The gantry began setting segments on January 28 at the abutment on 5th Street.

The Port Authority updated the City of Bayonne on the work activity that has been completed or is in progress around the various bridge piers.

At Pier N2, south of 1st Street, by the shoreline, footings are under construction. At Piers N3, N4, and N5, located south of 1st Street, work has been completed for now.

At Piers N6 and N7, between 1st and 2nd Street, drill shaft work, excavation for sixteen footings, and arsenic removal are underway. The Port Authority will be working in this area for several months.

At Pier N8, between 2nd Street and Gertrude Street, foundation testing is underway. At Pier N9, between Gertrude Street and 3rd Street, work has been completed for now.

Pier erection is in progress with the new crane at Pier N10, by 3rd Street (south side), and at Pier 11, by 3rd Street (north side). At Pier N12, between Juliette Street and 4th Street, by Slootsky Park on the Juliette Street side, at Pier N13, between Juliette Street, by Slootsky Park on the 4th street side, and at Pier N14, by Margaret Street., pier erection continues.

At Pier N15, at the bridge abutment, tower erection is underway, with the gantry setting segments.

The Port Authority has announced that there will be periodic 20minute traffic holds through December 2015. They will take place on announced days between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Motorists and community members should sign up for e-alerts on the Port Authority website for real-time information and scheduling of 20-minute holds.

The Port Authority has advised that various daytime, six-hour bridge closures are taking place between now and December 2015. Due to anticipated construction activities, and in the interest of public

safety, the Port Authority planned daytime closures of the Bayonne Bridge for Monday, February 2, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m., weather permitting, and then on Tuesday, February 3, and Wednesday, February 4.

Pier segment work was scheduled at Margaret Street from Friday, January 30, through Wednesday, February 4. All construction dates were and are subject to change based on work scheduling and weather. Closures to align and set pier segments are subject to change due to product issues no later than 4:00 p.m. the day before.



Extended Friday night closures, beginning Friday nights at 11:59 p.m., and ending Saturday nights at 11:59 p.m., were announced for January 30, and February 7.

A weekend bridge closure is expected February 20 to 23. That closure is scheduled to start on Friday night, February 20, at 9:00 p.m., and to run until Monday, February 23, at 5:00 a.m.

For bridge closure information: Please call 855-265-5482, and press 1.

The Port Authority has updated the list of street closures. Portions of West 4th Street will continue to be closed until June 2015. Portions of West 3rd Street will be closed effective February 5. Juliette Street or Gertrude Street will be closed daily, as needed, from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. While these sections of roadway are closed, vehicles can continue to enter from Kennedy Boulevard or Avenue A for local access only. No through traffic can travel under the Bayonne Bridge.



RAINN**WILSON** of 'Backstrom' on Fox



Are you a fan of detective shows such as "Backstrom"? I always loved them growing up. I never missed a "Rockford Files" or a "Columbo," and I think "Backstrom" is kind of the most messed-up version of "Columbo." We solve a crime every week, but it really is about how the character responds, and the quirkiness of the whole ensemble.

I love Dennis Haysbert, and he's become such a key part of the show; as Det. Sgt. Almond, he's kind of Backstrom's conscience and sounding board. He struggles with Backstrom's irascibility and rule-breaking, but he knows the greater good is being done because Backstrom is solving these crimes. What do you think sets Backstrom apart from your "Office" alter ego Dwight?

This is not Dwight as a police detective. This is a very tortured human being with a deep internal life, and he actively breaks the rules where Dwight was all about the rules.

Do you see any creative similarities to working on "Backstrom" and "The Office"?

difficult on the planet in terms of responsibility. You have to manage a budget and hundreds of people, and you have to be creative and have a vision for the show, and you have to be able to work with actors and writ-

Most of all, you have to be a great storyteller, and that's what Hart Hanson is ... a great, great storyteller.

Goldman takes cake decorating after hours on 'Duff Till Dawn



Take two professional bakers and their assistants, caffeinate them, keep them up well past midnight, turn them loose in a kitchen and see what results. That's the formula of Duff Goldman's new Food Network series "Duff Till Dawn," airing Thursdays.

The series, which premiered last week, takes place after business hours at Goldman's Los Angeles bakery, Duff's Cakemix, in which cake decorators do their thing after the sun goes down, with Goldman acting as host and adviser. The rules are few and emphasis is on creativity as the competition goes on overnight.

"We wanted this to feel very authentic, very, very real and like these are real cake decorators going at it head to head," Goldman explains. "We're literally stripping away all the rules because cake decorating is so much different than cooking. Even cake decorating is very different from most baking competitions, too. And I think with cake decorating competitions, you really have to do them right, and one of the things you have to do is you've got to remove a lot of those guidelines from people to allow them to do what they do because cake decorators are different from bakers and pastry chefs and cooks because they really are truly visual artists and you want to let them be able to do what they do."

And the competition ends as the sun comes up – literally.

"We look at like weather.com and it tells you sunrise is at 6:13 a.m.," Goldman says, "so at 6:13 a.m. hands off your cakes. It's different every night."

What book are you currently reading? "I am reading 'The War of Don Emmanuel's Nether Parts' by Louis de Bernieres. It's part of a trilogy. ... And basically it's kind of magical realism"

What did you have for dinner last night? "I'm eating raw right now, just because between filming shows I eat so much cake and stuff I try to stay healthy. So last night I had a watermelon, a green apple, celery, half of an avocado and carrots and I cheated with a little bit of peanut butter."

What is your next project?

"I'm actually writing a book right now that should be out October 2015, and it's called 'Duck Bakes.' ... We stripped away the stuff that people don't need to know and explained in very accessible terms like, 'This is why a good scone is good and this is why a bad scone is bad. This is why some pie dough is flaky and this is why some pie dough is mealy.' "

Alfonso Ribeiro doesn't consider himself a foodie, but rather a guy who loves American food.

Which makes his hosting the Monday Cooking Channel series "Unwrapped 2.0" something of an ideal assignment.

"I am the quintessential American eater," declares the 43-yearold former star of "The Fresh Prince of Bel-Air" and Season 19 cochampion (with Witney Carson) of ABC's "Dancing With the Stars." "I'm not super fancy. I'm not super creative. I love heartland-of-America-type foods. I mean, it's not really a surprising thing about how it's made. It's a lot of sugar (laughs) – a lot of sugar on a lot of different stuff. But ... how they do the honey buns, was kind of cool to me."

In Monday's episode, Ribeiro learns about the origins of sweet and sour. Other episodes delve into pork rinds, the pecan log roll and something called a chocolate salami.

"It is all-American stuff," Ribeiro says, "so it's the treat, rather than it be about burgers and those types of things. It's ultimately about the treats that we love.

"It's when you go to a football game, what do you have there? What comes with the meal? You know, the fun stuff, the stuff that kids love to eat. This is what this show is about. And that's really what attracted me to it, simply that I love all those treats. So it's a perfect marriage."

What book are you currently reading? "Right now, I don't

have time to really sit down and read a book, so I don't have one."

What did you have for dinner last night? "I had a filet mignon steak."

What is your next project?

"That's still to be determined. The next one that I have on the books, I'm directing a TV show for ABC Family."

When was your last vacation, where and why?

"My last vacation was right after the season of 'Dancing With the Stars,' where my wife and I went to the Andaz Hotel in Maui, Hawaii."





WOLFGANG PUCK'S KITCHEN

Reinforce healthy eating resolutions with a citrus glaze that gives big flavor to broiled fish By Wolfgang Puck

Now is the time that many New Year's resolutions to eat more healthfully begin to fade. And it's easy to understand why that happens as we approach late January.

For decades, psychologists have told us that it takes at least 21 days of repeated practice to form a new habit; and many more recent studies have concluded that, especially for more complicated behaviors, most people need much longer than that. Considering that healthy eating involves not just one behavior but manymaking the right ingredient choices, cooking them in ways that maximize flavor while minimizing fat and calories, avoiding overeating, and so many other practices-it's no wonder that resolve can begin to fade as the days and weeks, not to mention months, wear on.

That's why positive reinforcement can be

such an important factor. It could come from feeling your clothing getting looser, watching the numbers go down steadily on your scale (but don't weigh yourself more than once a week!), receiving a compliment from a friend or loved one, or simply realizing that you have more energy.

But reinforcement can and should also come directly from the food you cook and eat-from the pleasure it brings you with every bite. After all, the more delicious your healthy food is, the more likely you'll be to slow down and savor it, feeling more satisfied with sensible

portions. So I believe it's important, especially at times like now, to keep your eyes open for healthy new recipes that are, simply put, easy to make and exciting to eat.

That's why I'm so happy to share with you one of my favorite dishes from my book "Wolfgang Puck Makes It Healthy." It's a light yet flavorful recipe for quickly broiled fish fillets coated with a glaze of fresh citrus juice, a dollop of sweet-and-tangy marmalade, and lively touches of rice vinegar, fresh ginger, grated lemon zest and minced garlic. After no more than about 10 minutes total under the broiler, the fish is served with a refreshing little salad of watercress sprigs, which provides a crispy, peppery contrast to the tender seafood.

Yes, that's a combination of flavors that looks as beautiful and tastes as exciting as it sounds. And though the flavors are big, the fat and calorie levels are low-well under 200 calories per serving, and with less than a quarter of those calories coming from fat. Add a serving of your favorite whole-grain side for a nicely balanced main dish.

Try the glaze with any other kind of fish fillets each you like, too. And it also produces great results in the with boneless, skinless chicken breasts. The results will fill you with happiness, reinforcing ately.

your smart new eating habits. CITRUS-GLAZED HALIBUT FILLETS WITH WATERCRESS GARNISH Serves 4

CITRUS-GLAZED HALIBUT:

4 halibut fillets, each about 6 ounces (185 g) and 1 inch (2.5 cm) thick

- Freshly ground black pepper
- 1/4 cup (60 ml) rice vinegar
- $1/4 \operatorname{cup}(60 \text{ ml})$ fresh orange juice
- 1/4 cup (60 ml) fresh lemon juice
- Grated zest of 1/2 lemon

1/4 cup (60 ml) thin-shred orange or tangerine marmalade

1 teaspoon minced fresh ginger

1 teaspoon minced garlic

1 teaspoon minced fresh chile pepper, optional

1/2 teaspoon freshly ground white pepper Kosher salt

1 tablespoon peanut oil or vegetable oil WATERCRESS GARNISH:

2 cups (500 ml) small watercress sprigs 1 tablespoon rice vinegar Pinch kosher salt

> Pinch freshly ground white pepper Pinch sugar

Put the fish fillets in a dish large enough to hold them side by side. Grind a little black pepper over both sides of the fillets. Cover them with plastic wrap and

refrigerate until ready

to use. In a nonreactive saucepan, stir together the rice vinegar, orange juice, lemon juice, lemon zest, marmalade, ginger, garlic, chile pepper (if you want a spicier flavor), white pepper and salt to taste. Bring the mixture to a boil over medium-high heat; reduce the heat slightly and continue boiling until the mixture has reduced to

about $1/2 \operatorname{cup}(125 \operatorname{ml})$, 5 to 7 minutes. Remove the pan from the heat and set it aside, leaving the mixture to cool.

Whisk the oil into the cooled mixture. Remove the fish fillets from the refrigerator, uncover them, and spoon all of the glaze over the fillets, turning them to coat them evenly. Cover again with plastic wrap and refrigerate until ready to cook.

Meanwhile, preheat the broiler.

When the broiler is hot, transfer the fish fillets to a broiler pan or baking dish large enough to hold them in a single layer. Spoon the citrus glace left behind in the dish over them. Place the broiler pan or baking dish under the broiler and cook until the fish is nicely browned and barely cooked through in the center, 3 to 4 minutes per side depending on thickness, turning them once, carefully, with a spatula.

While the fish is broiling, prepare the watercress. Put the sprigs in a bowl and sprinkle with the vinegar, salt, white pepper and sugar. Toss well. Set aside.

As soon as the fish is done, place a fillet on each heated serving plate. Spoon any glaze left in the broiler pan or baking dish over the fish. Mound the watercress on top. Serve immediately.
